#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

#### PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The first year includes the general compulsory disciplines: Russian language and culture of speech, Law, Informatics and information technology, Economics, History of Russia, Foreign language. As well as basic philosophical disciplines: Logic, Introduction to the History of Philosophy, Philosophy and Culture of Ancient Greece and Ancient Rome, Philosophy and Culture of the Ancient East.

Second year includes study of such disciplines as Ontology and Epistemology, Ethics, Aesthetics, Theory and Practice of Argumentation, Middle Ages Philosophy and Culture, Russian Philosophy and Culture of X-XVIII centuries.

In the third year students study the basic courses: Social Philosophy, Philosophy and Methodology of Science, Renaissance and Modern Age Philosophy, Classical German Philosophy in the historical and cultural context of the XIXth century, Methods of Teaching Philosophical Disciplines. Area of expertise: Russian Philosophy and Culture in the XIXth Century, Philosophy of Love, Immanuel Kant and Russian Neo-Kantianism, N.N. Strakhov's Philosophy in the Context of Russian Intellectual Culture

The fourth year of study includes the development of basic and major disciplines: Philosophical problems of social sciences and humanities, Philosophical problems of natural and technical sciences, Modern foreign philosophy and culture, Russian philosophy and culture of the XX-XXI centuries, Karl Marx and Russian Marxism, Russian existentialism, M.M. Bakhtin and the philosophy of dialogue in foreign and domestic culture of the XX-XXI centuries, the problem of consciousness in modern foreign and domestic philosophy.

### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

After completing the program, a graduate can continue study in the Master's program "Philosophical Anthropology and Philosophy of Culture".

The professional activities of philosophy graduates are implemented: in socio-political and managerial activities; in pedagogical and analytical work; in media work; in public authorities.
