A number of subjects, such as Methodology of international research, Analysis of world affairs, Analysis of professional documents, form applied skills of scientific and research work.

Special attention is paid to the advanced learning of two foreign languages. The main types of educational activities are lectures and laboratory classes.

The training takes place in the format of lectures of practical classes. Each semester provides an internship that keeps students' research skills.
