ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

During the second year, students study lexicology, Russian culture, history of the main language, theoretical phonetics, practical phonetics, Russian as a foreign language (methodology of teaching), Contemporary technologies in the theory and practice of RLI teaching, and other specialized disciplines.

The third year continues in-depth study of specialized disciplines such as theory and methods of teaching Russian as a foreign language, theoretical grammar, linguoculturology, practice of culture and speech communication (Russian), listening and speaking in Russian. In the third year students continue studying the same disciplines.

In the fourth year students study modern Russian literature, history of world literature, language of mass media, history of Russian literature, theory and practice of translation.

The largest disciplines, which are studied in three to four years, are the first foreign language, listening and speaking in Russian, and practical training in the culture of speech communication (Russian). The main types of learning activities are lectures and practical classes. Practical training is provided in the sixth, seventh and eighth semesters. Training ends with the defense of the final qualification work.
