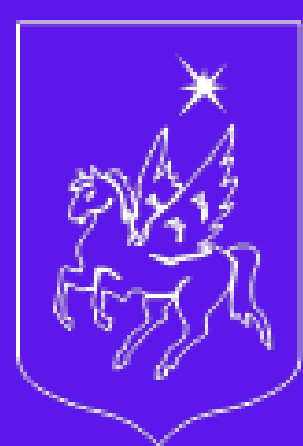

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with an education of the appropriate level, confirmed by a document on secondary general education or a document on vocational secondary education and qualifications, or a document on higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification are allowed to master the educational program.

APPLICATION

Application for acceptance of documents for enrolment (by mail).

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The first year of study implies the acquisition of fundamental knowledge, mastering general humanitarian, socio-economic disciplines such as logic, economics, history of state and law, theory of state.

The second year focuses on the basic disciplines (civil law, family law, criminal law and others).

The third year's curriculum is designed to continue the study of the basic and more advanced specialized subjects: consumer protection and protection of the rights of entrepreneurs and others. At the end of the course, students undertake an internship.

In the fourth year, they study such subjects as private international law, housing law and intellectual property law. Work experience in law enforcement is envisaged.

At the end of the fourth year, students take a State examination.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates can work for federal and regional public authorities, prosecutor's office, judiciary, in law enforcement system, and can be included in federal employee pool and employee pools of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation.
