ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with a bachelor's degree, as well as people with a higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist", have the right to participate in the competition for places funded from the budget allocations of the federal budget. Admission is based on an entrance test.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In the first year, the main specialized subjects are studied: Orthodoxy and Modern Society, Expert Advisory Activities in Theology, Professional Foreign Language, New Religious Movements, Theological Hermeneutics and Social Analysis of Religious Texts, Organization of Research Activities, Ideologies of Violence and Non-Violence in Cultural and Anthropological Practices of World Religions, Linguistic Analysis of Religious Texts. Term paper (project) is carried out. Introduction practical training is being conducted.

In the second year, the following is studied: Religious situation and religious extremism in the world and in Russia; Professional ethics of an expert religious scholar. In the last term, the main time is devoted to the preparation of a thesis within the framework of pre-graduation practical training and practice in the profile of professional activity. Special courses are studied: Religious situation in the Belgorod region: history and modernity, Islam and society in modern Russia, Rights and duties of an expert theologian in court session, Relations of the expert with government entities and public organizations, etc.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates receive recommendations for continuing their postgraduate studies. They are provided with support for employment in spiritual and educational centers, centers for spiritual and moral education of the population, departments and departments for working with youth, state and private expert centers, teaching in universities and institutions of vocational schools, public authorities, public organizations and commercial structures.
